GSPIA

Many GSPIA courses either have qualified or would qualify as electives. Good choices include PIA 2101 (Managing Emergencies and Disasters), PIA 2303 (Security & Intelligence Studies: Theories and Public Policy), PIA 2412 (Analyzing Critical International Security Challenges), PIA 2490 (Prevention, Treatment and Control of Global Infectious Diseases), PIA 2318 (Proliferation and Terror in the 21st Century), and PIA 2602 (National Security and Defense Transformation); others are possible.

SCHOOL OF NURSING

Many SON courses either have qualified or would qualify as electives. Good choices include NUR 1865 (Fundamentals of Disaster and Mass Casualty Care), NUR 2865 (Fundms Distr/Mass Casualty Cre), NUR 1760 (Nursing Care of Children in Disasters and Public Health Emergencies); others are possible.

OTHER GRADUATE SCHOOLS

Other Graduate-level courses from Pitt may also meet the elective requirements for the Certificate Program. In addition, up to 3 elective credits may be taken at other accredited universities.
